

# Dress Code and Appearance

## Physical Education

Students come to school on PE days with:

1. Gym Shirt (\*)
2. Navy blue gym pants
3. Sneakers and socks

(Girls are not to wear abayas on PE days)

## Girls:

1. Navy Blue 2-pc romper set consisting of jumper top and pants to be worn with a light blue shirt
2. Navy Blue Dress (worn with light blue shirt). Full length dresses for students in grades 4<sup>th</sup> and higher
3. Navy Blue Abaya with navy blue pants underneath.
4. White Hijab – required for fourth grade and above
5. Navy blue skirts - skirts must be full length for grades 4<sup>th</sup> and higher.
6. Light blue shirts – long sleeve for grades 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>.

(\*) – item to be ordered and purchased through the school.

## Boys:

1. Light blue shirt
2. Navy blue pants

## Jum'a:

Jum'a is like "Eid", and we should look our best.

Girls: The dress, skirt or abaya

Boys: White or Blue Jubba/Thowb or Shalwar Kamees or suit;  
white kufi - for 4<sup>th</sup> grade & higher

## Sweaters:

Solid navy blue cardigans, hoodies, and sweaters may be worn on colder days. Uniform shirts and sweaters must be **LOGO FREE** and be purchased from a uniform apparel found in specific sections in many department stores.

## Other Mandatory Policies:

Considering the Prophetic saying, "Cleanliness is half of faith" - Students must also wear clean clothes, free from stains, tears and holes. Nails must be short, clean and clear from polish (for wudhu purposed). Hair should always be combed and neat.
